



Civic Action Statement Planning Retreats

Join us for one of these two-day civic action planning retreats where Wisconsin Campus Compact (WiCC), a department of the University of Wisconsin-Extension, will convene institutional teams from its member institutions to plan their Civic Action steps! These events are designed to bring together institutional teams so they can engage in the Civic Action Planning Process together, as a cohort of institutions. WiCC will provide structured activities and resources to help institutions consider how to create a meaningful Civic Action Plan. We recommend that institutional teams of between **4-8** people comprised of upper level administration, civic engagement staff, faculty, and community partners (ideally, at least one of each). Your team can attend either event location that's most convenient for you, and you're not limited to one location based on your institution's location.

The **\$70/person** registration fee includes continental breakfast and lunch on both days. There will be meat and vegetarian options available at lunch only. The vegetarian options will serve as the option for those individuals who require gluten-free options. Standard continental breakfast (doughnuts, bagels, and croissants and coffee or tea) is provided both days, and these are created using standard ingredients for those items, which may include eggs. NOTE: There will be NO shellfish or nuts in any of the food items offered throughout this event.
